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Preface

This Standard was prepared by the joint Standards Australia/Standards New Zealand Committee WS-014, Plumbing and Drainage, to supersede AS/NZS 3500.0—2003, *Plumbing and Drainage, Part 0: Glossary of terms*.

3A.1 ablution trough See *trough* (<u>3T.42.1</u>)

3A.2 absorber See solar water heater—terms (<u>3S.105.1</u>)

3A.3 absorption pit soakaway

pit, trench or well dug into permeable ground, filled with broken stone, bricks or large granular material and usually covered with earth, where liquid may soak away into the ground

3A.4 absorption test See *test* (<u>3T.14.1</u>)

3A.5 access chamber See *chamber* (<u>3C.14.1</u>)

3A.6 access cover See *cover* (<u>3C.73.1</u>)

3A.7 access fitting See *fitting* (<u>3F.22.1</u>)

3A.8

access opening opening in a building element, fitted with a removable cover, to allow maintenance of a concealed pipe, fixture or other apparatus

3A.9 access pipe See *pipe* (<u>3P.17.1</u>)
